

### **Purpose**

This document describes the procedure for proper installation of factory released firmware for BK Radio 5000 channel, BKR portable, KNG2 portable, KNG portable, and KNG mobile radios.

#### **Radio Models**

#### **Mobile Radio Models:**

KNG-M150, KNG-M400, KNG-M500, KNG-M800, and KNG-MxxxR

#### **Mobile Radio Control Heads:**

KAA0660 and KAA0670

#### **Portable Radio Models:**

BKR5000, KNG2-P150, KNG2-P400, KNG2-P500, KNG2-P800, KNG-P150, KNG-P400, KNG-P500, and KNG-P800

In addition to model types, the KNG Portable is available in two versions. 5000 channel, P25 Trunking Capable/Upgradable or 512 channel, P25 Conventional only (KNG-S models).


These instructions are for 5000 channel versions only.

#### Portable Radio Identification

Your radio version can be determined by observing the LCD display during power up or from the radio serial number.

Trunking Capable/Upradable KNG-S Conventional Only

Serial Tag

Model No.: KNG-P-400 SN:1000 **0**123 FCC ID: K95KNGP400 IC: 2116A-KNGP400 5000 Channel, P25 Trunking Capable/Upgradable version will display the BK Technologies logo at power-up and have a "9" as the fifth digit in the serial number.

KNG-S version will briefly display the radio model number at power up and have a "0" as the fifth digit in the serial number.

These instructions do not apply to KNG-S model portables.




### **Important**

KNG2 radios with firmware version <5.5.0f will not be properly detected in Lightning Light. Please read and follow the directions at the end of this document to update correctly.

#### **Portable Radio Installation**

- 1. Open the zipped file containing firmware update files.
- 2. Run the executable file to install Lightning Light.
- 3. Open the program from the Windows start menu.
- 4. Connect the radio to the PC via program cable.
- 5. While holding the radios push-to-talk, turn on radio power. (Note: The radio must be connected to the computer before power-up.)
- 6. When the top LED flashes blue, release the push-to-talk button.
- 7. Lightning Light will automatically detect the correct device to updated. Click "Start" to begin the update.




- 8. A status bar will indicate the progress of the firmware update.
- 9. Wait for the radio to reboot then disconnect the radio from the PC.
- 10. Exit the program by clicking the "X" at the top right or start at step 4 to update another radio.



### **Mobile Radio Installation**

- 1. Open the zipped file containing firmware update files.
- 2. Run the executable file to install Lightning Light.
- 3. Open the program from the Windows start menu.
- 4. Connect the radio to the PC via USB cable.
- 5. While holding the microphones push-to-talk, turn on radio power. (Note: The radio must be connected to the computer before power-up.)
- 6. When the front LED flashes blue, release the push-to-talk button.
  (KNG-MxxxR Note: as there is no front LED, release the push-to-talk button when the Lightning Light program Status changes to "Ready".)
- 7. Lightning Light will automatically detect the correct device to updated. Click "Start" to begin the update.



- 8. A status bar will indicate the progress of the firmware update.
- 9. Wait for the radio to reboot then disconnect the radio from the PC.
- 10. Exit the program by clicking the "X" at the top right or start at step 4 to update another radio.


NOTE: MOBILE RADIO FIRMWARE CANNOT BE INSTALLED VIA A REMOTE HEAD.

PC CONNECTION MUST BE MADE DIRECTLY TO THE RADIO CORE.



### Mobile Radio Remote Control Head (KAA0660) Installation

- 1. Open the zipped file containing firmware update files.
- 2. Run the executable file to install Lightning Light.
- 3. Open the program from the Windows start menu.
- 4. Connect the remote control head to the PC via USB cable.
- 5. While holding the push-to-talk on the microphone connected to the remote control head, turn on radio power. (Note: The radio must be connected to the computer before power-up.)
- 6. When the front LED flashes blue, release the push-to-talk button.
- 7. Lightning Light will automatically detect the correct device to updated. Click "Start" to begin the update.




- 8. A status bar will indicate the progress of the firmware update.
- 9. Wait for the radio to reboot then disconnect the radio from the PC.
- 10. Exit the program by clicking the "X" at the top right or start at step 4 to update another radio.



### Mobile Radio Handheld Control Head (KAA0670) Installation

- 1. Open the zipped file containing firmware update files.
- 2. Run the executable file to install Lightning Light.
- 3. Open the program from the Windows start menu.
- 4. Connect the handheld control head to the PC via USB cable.
- 5. While holding the push-to-talk on the handheld control head, turn on radio power. (Note: The radio must be connected to the computer before power-up.)
- 6. When the front LED flashes blue, release the push-to-talk button.
- 7. Lightning Light will automatically detect the correct device to updated. Click "Start" to begin the update.



- 8. A status bar will indicate the progress of the firmware update.
- 9. Wait for the radio to reboot then disconnect the radio from the PC.
- 10. Exit the program by clicking the "X" at the top right or start at step 4 to update another radio.



### Important for Radios with older Firmware

All-in-One Lightning Light includes the firmware for HCH, Mobile, Portable, Portable-G2 and RCH. It will automatically detect the correct device once the device is put into the flashing mode.

KNG2 radios with firmware version <5.5.0f will not be properly detected, follow the instructions below.

- 1. Open the Lightning Light executable.
- 2. Navigate to the "Options" menu at the top.
- 3. Select "Flash <5.5.0c KNG2s"
- 4. Choose "Portable-G2" from the "Builds" section.
- 5. Click "Start" to begin update.
